Evaluation Methods Used: Testing the Recruiting portal involved a combination of automated, manual, and functional testing on a desktop. Level Access (Level) comprehensively tested a selection of pages representative of the Recruiting portal candidate experience using, among other methodologies, the screen readers JAWS 2019 and NVDA 2020, exclusive use of the keyboard, and manual inspection of code. Level also functionally tested two typical user flows with JAWS 2019.
